Student goals for SLC conversations are:

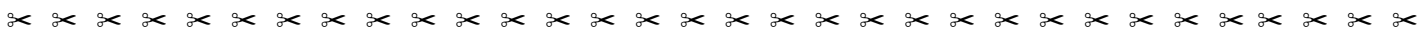
- Sharing academic/class portfolios of schoolwork.
